APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT FOR WATER SERVICES

The undersigned applicant hereby applies to Lake Rockport Estates Property Owners Association, Inc., a property owners association in the State of Utah (referred to as "Lake Rockport Estates"), for access to single-family residential seasonal (May 1st through October 31st) water service from Lake Rockport Estates and approval of plans for the property at the lot number noted below.

The undersigned agrees to pay all connection assessments, impact assessments, construction road assessments, construction damage charges, and other related assessments and charges to Lake Rockport Estates in full as they become due. Assessments will be according to the current assessment schedule in place at the time these connections and improvements are made. Payment of all required assessments and charges and the use of water for a detached single-family residence only is a condition for the continued service of water to the property described below. All assessments must be kept current and paid on time. The undersigned hereby agrees to comply fully with all ordinances, assessment schedules, rules and regulations, and restrictions including the Drought Response Plan in force at the date of this agreement or to be enacted in the future by Lake Rockport Estates.

This agreement is executed by the property owner or by an authorized agent of the property owner. By accepting seasonal water services from Lake Rockport Estates, the property owner agrees to be bound by the terms of this agreement and the Bylaws of Lake Rockport Estates.
